“RUSSISK MENTALITET OG IDENTITET”

Oplægget præsenteres på letforståelig engelsk

What do ordinary Russians want from Putin’s fourth term, and the prospects of them getting it?

In this talk Jeremy will review the latest social and political events in Russia since Putin’s re-election to his fourth term in office in 2018. Will his government be able to meet the increasing expectations among ordinary Russians that their socio-economic conditions will improve, while weathering increasing sanctions and increasing awareness of the vast inequality and levels of corruption at the highest level? As an anthropologist, rather than relying on the press and elite analysis about the latest shuffling of government posts, known as ‘kremlin logical’ tarot reading, Jeremy bases his thoughts and judgements on long-term interactions within his ethnographic fieldwork within ordinary Russians interlocutors, both in Moscow and further - in the ‘glubinka’ and the real Russia.
